## **Prospectus**

#### **Eligibility and Media**

This exhibition is open to any artist 18 years of age or older. If you live outside the United States, please contact gallery for additional submission guidelines.

Eligible are any artist bookworks other than SPOD (Self Published On Demand such as Lulu, Blurb and so forth). Books may be editioned or unique, sculptural or more traditionally bound, interactive or passive. Books that measure more than 14 inches (closed) in any dimension are ineligible. Works must be exhibitable in a case (i.e. no wall hung works).

Maximum of 3 artworks may be submitted per artist.

### Early Bird Entry Deadline December 23, 2016 Deadline to enter February, 2017

#### Fees/Submission

Entry fee for this exhibit is \$12 for each entry submitted before midnight (MST) December 23, 2016\*, \$15 for each entry submitted after December 23, 2016.

You needn't enter your submissions all at the same time. Submission for this exhibition is by file upload only. To upload your entries please click on this link: http://bit.ly/celebrate-submissions

\*\*Please send gallery quality images without background clutter or text. DO NOT send composite images or images with embedded text. If your work is accepted for exhibition, the images you enter with as well as the text you provide will be used for print & digital publicity. Any work represented with substandard images will be re-photographed at artists' expense.

Please note that you will not be able to change any information submitted at time of entry, including the price, after the submission process.

#### Sales

It is expected that all work exhibited be for sale. Sales will be encouraged. Abecedarian Gallery retains 40% on all sales. The prices you submit during the entry process are the retail prices the gallery will adhere to throughout the duration of the exhibition.

#### **Catalogs**

There will be a print and online color catalog in conjunction with the exhibition. Print catalogs will be for sale after the exhibition. The online catalog will remain online during and after the exhibition.

#### **Accepted Entries**

Works must be delivered ready for installation/display. Gallery reserves the right not to exhibit any work not accurately represented by the digital entry, arrives damaged, is not properly prepared for exhibition or is deemed too fragile for effective display.

#### **Insurance**

Roundtrip shipping and insurance is the responsibility of the artist.

Abecedarian retains a 40% commission on works sold during the exhibit.

#### Display

Works will be exhibited in glass display cases. Library visitors will not be able to handle the work while on display. There will be two open-case talks during the exhibition during which select works will be removed from the displays by library and gallery staff to allow visitors a closer look during the presention.

# Celebrate!

On acceptance to the exhibition, a consignment agreement, insurance agreement and delivery guidelines will be sent to each participating artist, along with any additional information or changes.

Work will be insured for 60% of the stated retail value during the course of the exhibit. Insurance in transit to and from Abecedarian Gallery is the responsibility of the artist.

It is expected that submitting artists are not violating any stated or implied relationship with another gallery or dealer by submitting work for this exhibiton and that the artist/creator of the work is not in violation of any copyright laws.

#### Agreement

Submission of entry constitutes agreement to all conditions in this prospectus.

The artist agrees that images of selected artwork and the submitted text can be used by the gallery and by
University of Denver Libraries for promotions and publications.
